1. APOLOGIES

There were none.

4. DISCLOSURE OF INTERESTS AND DISPENSATIONS

5. LICENSING ACT 2003 - THE GEORGE, 40 TOWER BRIDGE ROAD, SE1 1JL

The licensing officer advised that all parties had agreed conditions as alternative interim steps to those imposed at the sub-committee hearing on 11 September 2014.

All parties confirmed that they were satisfied that the agreed conditions would satisfy the licensing objectives.

The licensing sub-committee went into closed session at 12.15pm.

The licensing sub-committee resumed at 12.20pm and the chair read out the decision of the sub-committee.

RESOLVED:

That the decision that the premises licence be suspended as an interim step be modified as follows:

1. That the premises shall be closed to members of the public by 21.30 each day.
2. That the sale of alcohol by retail shall end at 21.15 each day and closed by 21.30.
3. That a personal licensee shall be present at all times licensable activities are carried on at the premises.
4. That Mr Steven Glover shall be excluded from the licensed area of the premises. He is allowed to reside upstairs and admittance shall be from the Leroy Street entrance only
5. That after 18.00 there shall be no less than two staff on duty.
6. That all pool cues shall be stored behind the bar area and shall be released by staff only.

That the interim steps be modified to the following steps until 7 October 2014 or until such time that the review is determined.

Reasons

The licensing sub-committee determined that the modified conditions to the interim steps imposed on 11 September 2014 were proportionate and necessary.

Appeal rights

There is no right of appeal to a magistrates' court against the licensing authority's decision at this stage.

The premises licence holder may make representation against any interim steps imposed and a hearing to consider the representation will be held within 48 hours of receipt of the representation.

Any representation should be in writing and cannot be received outside of normal office hours.
